

# GA1 Submission Eligibility Form

As of September 13, 2022, members of the Law Society of Alberta are required to utilize the [Surrogate Digital Service](#) for all applications it is able to process. If you are submitting your application on a GA1 form, this eligibility form **must** be completed and attached to your application. On this form you will indicate the reason you cannot use SDS for your application. GA1 forms that are not accompanied by this form will be rejected. A Submission Eligibility Form is **not** required when filing forms other than the GA1.

**NOTE:** As of April 4, 2023, SDS accepts applications with Trust Company applicants.
